To Whom It May Concern:


Wladyslaw Wojcik, age 60, of 99-44 62nd Ave., Rego Park, N.Y. has been under my care since 3/10/77 as a result of a heart attack. He was hospitalized at the Parkway Hospital in Forest Hills, N.Y. in the intensive care unit for a period of two weeks, under the supervision of Jules Levine, M.D., Cardiologist. He has been seen on numerous occasions in consultation by Dr. Levine since his discharge from the hospital

In addition to the above illness Mr. Wojcik is suffering from a compound fracture with dislocation of the right hand and wrist since 5/19/78. Open reduction was done at Parkway Hospital, with orthopedic pins implanted and a plaster cast applied to above the elbow. He is under the care of Doctors Rosenhain, Jalens and Mauer of 108th St., Forest Hills.

This fracture and its complications have aggravated his heart condition causing undue strain. He is totally disabled and it appears unlikely that he will be able to resume normal activities.

Medications prescribed are Indesol, Nitroglycerine, Isodril, Lasax and Valium. Prognosis is guarded.
